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1. Primary Function: Assists in the implementation and maintaining of art programs in district schools with primary emphasis in elementary schools.
2. Responsible to: Director, Instructional Services.
3. Assigned Responsibilities:
  - 3.01 Offers opportunities for teachers to see techniques of instruction or teaching materials in actual use.
  - 3.02 Develops and disseminates resources for art instruction.
  - 3.03 Arranges for school-community interaction which may include art fairs, shows, and volunteer service in the arts.
  - 3.04 Develops simple teaching strategies to enable instructors to correlate learning activities with district objectives.
  - 3.05 Matches activities and materials to individual and group skills and needs.
  - 3.06 Ensures that instructional activities and materials are clearly related to District, school, and department goals and objectives.
  - 3.07 Establishes and maintains a good working relationship with building administrators and staff cooperating to resolve problems in a professional manner so that the concerns of all parties are considered.

  - 3.09 Assists with the development and revision of the district's art program as assigned.
