1. Primary Function: Instructs classes in Health Education so that students develop increased knowledge and individual skills in caring for their own health and the health of others.
2. Responsible to: Building Principal.
3. Assigned Responsibilities:
 - 3.01 Teaches students the information included in the district adopted curriculum in the areas of (a) physical health, (b) mental health, (c) community health, and (d) safety.
 - 3.02 Matches the health activities and materials to individual and group skills and needs.
 - 3.03 Organizes content and skills of the health program so learning objectives are recognizable to the student and other observers.
 - 3.04 Presents materials and activities in a positive manner so that students are motivated to lead healthy and active lives.
 - 3.05 Uses a variety of teaching strategies (discussion, lecture, group activity, and individual projects) to encourage class participation.
 - 3.06 Reports to students the latest facts relating to health topics being taught.
 - 3.07 Ensures that health instructional activities and materials are clearly related to district, school, and department goals and objectives.
 - 3.08 Provides health instruction based on designated instructional guides or develops alternate materials in prescribed district format.
 - 3.09 Establishes and maintains an orderly and supportive classroom environment in which students are actively participating and show respect for one another and for the teacher.
 - 3.10 Maximizes time when students are paying attention and working on tasks directly related to the health subject matter.
 - 3.11 Conducts interesting and well-paced classes using a variety of instructional techniques, strategies, materials, and media appropriate to the lesson.
 - 3.12 Makes sure students understand what to do before undertaking assignments.
 - 3.13 Assesses, keeps track of, and provides feedback promptly and often to students on their progress and assignments.
 - 3.14 Uses a grading system that is consistent, fair, and supportable.
 - 3.15 Selects and requisitions required health films and filmstrips.
 - 3.16 Ensures that health media equipment is properly used, maintained, and stored, and that inventory records are accurate and current.
 - 3.17 Supervises students in out-of-classroom activities as assigned.
 - 3.18 Participates cooperatively on school, area, and district-wide health activities.
 - 3.19 Follows specified standards, policies, and procedures of the building and district.
